### ECRIN – a distributed research infrastructure

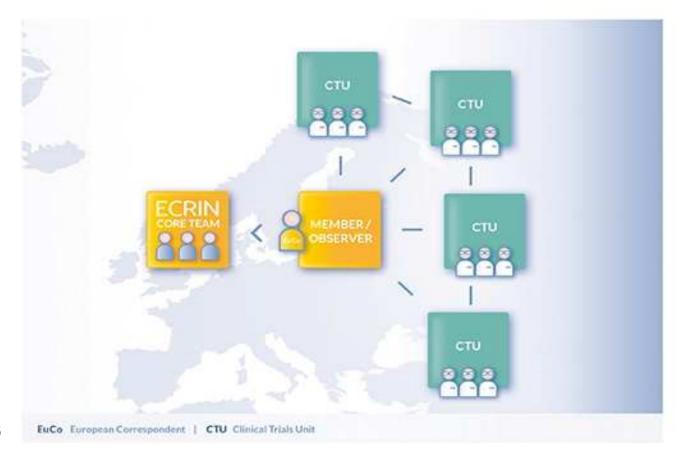
•with **ERIC legal status** since November 29th, 2013 (awarded by the European Commission)

## **INVOLVEMENT OF ECRIN IN H2020**

## Calls 2014-2015

## •2014

- 32 proposals sent with ECRIN as a Partner
- 4 projects funded and 2 on waiting list (finally not funded)

## •2015

- 20 proposals sent with ECRIN as a Partner
- 4 projects funded



### Involvement in 21 proposals / 3 funded projects (2014-2015):

- 2 coordinated by French teams: FAIR-PARK II, MEDIT-



# Success story ...

## **Example: FAIR-PARK II**

•PHC-13-2014: New therapies for chronic non-communicable disease

•Coordinated by Pr David DEVOS, CHRU Lille

•Budget : 5,998 M€

•Duration: 5 years

•16 partners: 8 clinical Partners (1/country – Coord National), ECRIN, Patient

association, Pharma company, Inserm-Transfert ...

### •1 multinational trial:

- PI: Pr Devos (CHRUL— France)
- 8 countries (FR, CZ, DE, NL, UK, ES, PT, AT)
- 4 ancillary studies







# FAIR-PARK



TIMELINES: from the call to the start of the project (2 stages)

Dec. 2013 : Publication of the call

March 2014: Deadline 1st stage

- May 2014: Results of the 1st stage

Aug 2014 : Deadline 2<sup>nd</sup> stage

Jan 2015: Results

**May 2015: Start of the Project** 

Letter of Intent: 2,5/3 months (design, partners, general organisation)

Full proposal: 4 months to finalize everything with all the partners (scientific content, tasks, budget, writing)

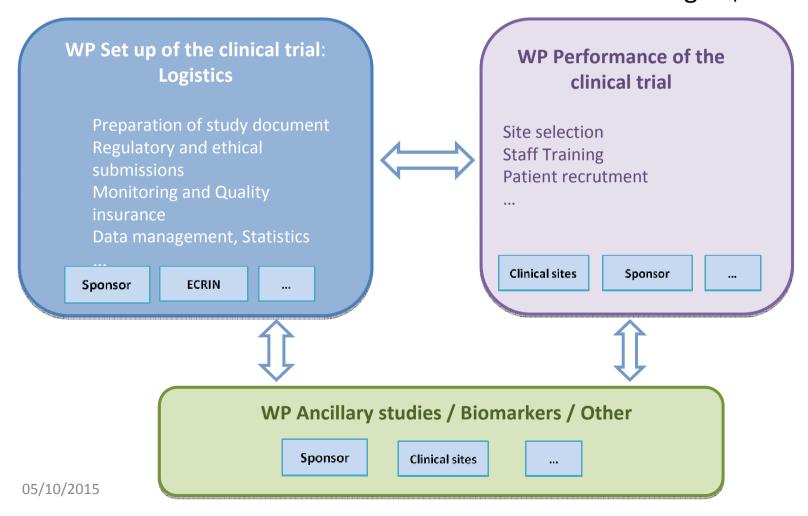
3,5 months for signature with EU Commission

# FAIR-PARK



- ORGANISATION OF THE TRIAL Strengh of this project beyond scientific aspects
  - Coordinator fully supported by his institution (administrative and financial support)
  - Design of the trial: open discussion with all the partners
  - Feasibility of the trial: country/country
  - WP Performance of the trial: European Network of clinical sites
     (+++) → KOL involved in a same project
  - Involvement of 8 countries with a good balance of tasks distibution and WP leadership



# DIFFICULTIES TO BUILD UP A MULTINATIONAL PROJECT

- (NOT EXHAUSTIVE AND BASED ON MY PERSONAL EXPERIENCE!)
  - Lack of support to the Coordinator (Institution / Sponsor)
  - Network of European clinical partners: takes time to build up a EU network but it's absolutely necessary
  - Clinical partners not really supportive
  - Lack of communication between partners and thus clinical trial not well defined
  - The trial is the main aspect of the project but ethics, health-economy,
    ... are also evaluated and part of the project
  - Budget: cost evaluation



# DIFFICULTIES TO BUILD UP A MULTINATIONAL PROJECT

### NOT TO OVERLOOK

- TIME
  - Preparation of the dossier takes time for the Coordinator and for all the Partners (Delegation ...)
  - When you will plan the tasks: don't be too optimistic

### COMMUNICATION:

- Regular TCs (+++) with European Partners
- Physical meeting (if possible)
- COLLABORATIVE PROJECT!





## **NEW INITIATIVE: ECRIN On Board**

- The "ECRIN-On-Board" initiative offers support to multinational, clinical research projects preparing a H2020 application for the SC1 2016 call:
  - early collaborative involvement of ECRIN in the H2020 application process
  - provides free support to project development through:
    - Independent consulting on methodology during protocol development
    - Consulting on logistical and operational aspects of the clinical trial with a focus on the international nature
    - Advice on clinical aspects of the H2020 application: work package architecture, impact
    - (however ECRIN will not draft the application)
